Thank you for taking the time to read my personal statement regarding the vacancy for the Ward 1 Councillor role in Kincardine, Ontario.

I write this message to you in a very different position than I was in just a few months ago on January 6th when I spoke to Council about the Ward 3 vacancy. This is something I believe many of Kincardine's old and new constituents share with me today.

Last time I was a newly arrived, expectant parent, with a six-month lease and the hope that my family had not made a mistake by packing up our home, dogs, and lives to make our dream of returning to my partner's hometown a reality. We were under the care of the fantastic Grey-Bruce Midwives team and aside from a worrying sign that one of the local ERs was closed at night due to a nursing shortage and another was fundraising for basic care x-ray equipment, I was pretty sure we had made the correct decision to move here to Kincardine.

Now, after a birth, a visit to Emergency for myself, and an ambulance trip including fire trucks and 911 for our new child during a COVID19 scare; and despite an ongoing search for follow-up care, I am happy to say we are celebrating our family's one year anniversary in Kincardine safe, happy and healthy. Those worries continue, but I have become a content permanent resident and a very proud but worried-for-the-present parent of a new future Kincardinite. I am looking for ways to contribute to the continuing improvement of my community.

As we'd hoped, Grey Bruce has done exceedingly well so far with COVID19 but with that success comes challenges, including a wave of new residents here in Kincardine. This growth is exciting and I look forward to the opportunity to work with my fellow representatives to balance the interests of future and existing residents as the Town continues to grow.

Currently I run a small sole proprietorship providing waste collection information technology services to restaurants. Prior to that, I worked for and with the Province of Ontario, including the Ministries of Health and Municipal Affairs and Housing. I was involved in a number of high profile and successful GTA projects, including my work with the health system during H1N1. I believe my past roles have provided me with much relevant experience to assist the Kincardine Council to improve the lives of residents like me. I am currently on parental leave which will continue past the end of the current term so I don't anticipate any problem meeting the needs and time commitment of Council.

Finally, thanks in advance for your consideration of my application for this vacancy. Whether this petition is successful or not I look forward to having you as either colleagues or representatives. Please
