Jenna will do a write up for 372 Durham Street to add it to the next update of the Kincardine Walking Tour. There are currently four boxes of the walking tours at the Tourism Office. The committee discussed the need to have QR codes in the next addition including not having them as the links can easily be broken. Tourism Staff has put inserts into the existing tours to fix this issue. Sylvia will confirm how many Bruce Township Driving Tours there are and how many we might need to order.

The Committee discussed how we might heighten the Walking/Driving Tours on the Municipal website including creating a short link, put it in See and Do and putting it on the homepage of the website.
