## 5 YEAR GOAL SUMMARY

#### 2022

- Explore the expansion of Cigarette Butt Station program
- Explore the purchase of a Water Bottle Filling Station within the Municipality
- Final the Native Species/ Plant/ Tree information and listing
- Explore the creation of a tree planting plan

#### 2023

- Creation of a Sustainable Recognition Policy for the Municipality of Kincardine
- Expand Water Bottle Filling Stations to locations throughout the Municipality of Kincardine (ie. Downtown Kincardine, Tiverton, and Station Beach)
- Explore possible grant opportunities
- Support the incorporation of perennial native plants in Municipal gardens, phase out majority of annuals
- Continue to support the restoration of Riggin and Savage Parks
- Evaluate the use of rodenticides on Municipal properties, find alternatives that could eliminate use of rodenticides

#### 2024

- Explore the possibility of a community compost program
- Review special event application process and include requirements for limiting negative environmental impact (e.g. compost and recycling receptacles, eliminate single use plastics where possible, etc.)
- Explore the opportunity to be designated as a "Blue Community"

#### 2025

- Explore, develop, and implement a Climate Change Action Plan for the Municipality of Kincardine
