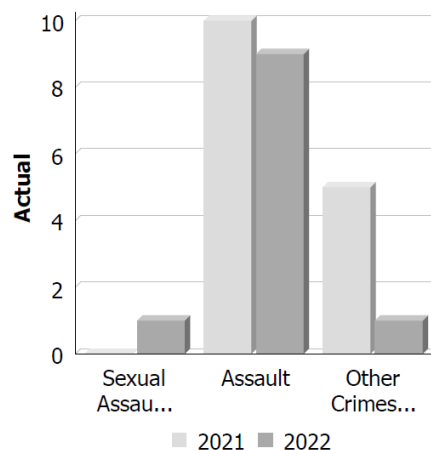

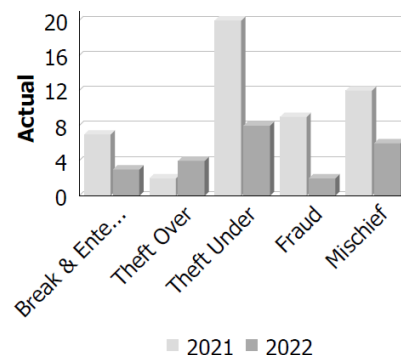

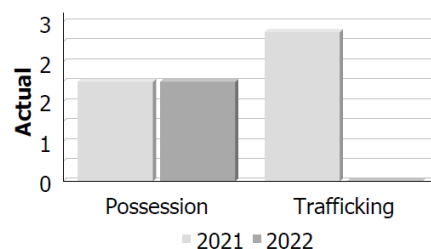

Detachment Updates

Calls For Service of Note

- **Sex Assault**
 - We have seen an increase in Sex Assault complaints year to date. A number of these complaints are Domestic related or involve family members. Two of the complaints involve individuals who were met via a dating app. Two involve youth and three are historical in nature.
- **Theft Over**
 - One of the Theft Over involved the theft of a pickup truck, an ATV and a Side by Side totaling more than \$50,000.00 from a business. Investigation led to the arrest of two individuals for possession of the stolen truck and the truck was recovered.
 - The theft of a Mobile scooter was discovered to be unfounded as it was borrowed without the owner's knowledge by a family member.
 - A stolen Jeep was recovered and the investigating officers received a "Gold Star" of appreciation from the owner.
- **Traffic Updates** – South Bruce OPP officers joined our Highway Safety Division officers on a Commercial Motor Vehicle blitz on Aug 3rd. They were also joined by a member of MTO.
 - 19 Commercial Motor Vehicles were inspected
 - 6 were pulled from service
 - 13 charges were laid
- **Traffic Updates** – A media reminder was sent to the community regarding the legislation around golf cars vs Low Speed vehicles after a couple of warnings were given to individuals driving golf carts on Municipal Roads.

Community Events

- Officers conducted foot patrol throughout the Scottish Festival festivities on the July Long Weekend.
- Officers were pleased to be invited to attend the Hindu Culture Open House where they received recognition alongside other First Responders.
- Inspector MILLER attended the Kincardine Fire Service training in July to present a number of fire fighters as well as Police Officers Regional Commander letters of Exemplary Service for their teamwork shown during an investigation at the Kincardine marina. The First Responders were commended for their professionalism and ability to work together under difficult and public circumstances.
