On behalf of the residents of what was the former Bruce Township, now Ward three and the Bruce Township Historical Society, we are very sad that the new sign has been put up in a new location that is so far back off the highway, that it can hardly be seen. The old sign was located just south of North Bruce on highway 21, on the west side of the highway. A few years ago, the Highway Department told us that it was distracting where it was on the property of Bruce Ransome. That sign should have been grandfathered in its location.

Bruce said the sign could be placed up on the knoll of the hill closer to the highway on the west side. There is another sign for West Coast Catering which our sign could be placed beside to be more noticeable. The West Coast Catering sign is located much closer to the highway. It seems sad to have a sign that no one can even see.
