Executive Summary:

The intent of this report is to inform Council of any compliance related issues and general information from the Environmental Services Department for the month of August 2023.

Purpose of Report:

The report includes a summary of water sampling results additional to the weekly required Bacteriological testing and Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks Inspection Reports received in the month of August 2023.

Context and Background Information:

Sampling

On August 14, all municipal drinking water systems were tested for pH and Alkalinity as part of the Lead Testing Program required under Ontario Regulation 170/03 Drinking Water Systems. All the sample results received were within the acceptable limits. The municipality is operating under a reduced Lead sampling program with lead only required to be sampled every third sample period and is scheduled for 2024.

Ministry Inspection Reports

The MECP Final Inspection Report for the June 29th annual inspection at the Armow Drinking Water System was received on August 16th. There were no non-compliances noted or orders issued in the report. A copy of the report is provided in the attachments.
