 - Carly: CSWBP covers lots of the important topics. Supports dissolving the Committee. No saying we can't revisit or re-establish the Committee in the future.
 - Jason: networking can continue between group members
 - Marilyn: 5 action tables of CSWBP don't really cover children's safety. Worries it will fall off the radar. Suggested to keep a workshop going annually to talk about these topics.
 - Jeremy: Take to CSWBP that there is an interest in safety issues and how can the CSWBP address that?
 - Decision to close the social media accounts. One final memo for Wally to share.
 - In Committee members are interested in Action tables, contact Alexis at CSWBP.
 - Kevin Martin: school bus cameras still a great idea and we need video footage for court and to lay charges. Sad to see it go but okay if the work is being picked up. Human trafficking needs to stay at the table. Kevin retiring by March. He received a Road Safety Achievement award!! from the MTO.
