Petition in opposition to the Draft Plan of Subdivision Application, Tidman S-2022-15

To the Municipality of Kincardine:

I oppose the Draft Plan of Subdivision Application regarding the proposed development in Inverhuron lots 6 to 10; E Victoria St W Albert Street, File number S-2022-15, Z-2022-084, Municipality of Kincardine (Bruce Township), Roll Number 410826000411900

I urge you to reject the Draft Plan of Subdivision Application on environmental and ecological grounds. The development in question is proposed on a parcel of land adjacent to the Inverhuron Provincial Park, and currently consists of significant woodland features, significant wildlife habitat (SWH) including habitat for endangered and threatened species (EIS prepared by Sumac Environmental Consulting Ltd.)

Ontario's *Endangered Species Act* (ESA) states that no person shall damage or destroy the habitat of a species that is listed on the Species at Risk in Ontario List as an endangered or threatened species. As per Section C2.3.3 of the Official Plan of the Municipality of Kincardine, 2021, development and site alteration shall not be permitted in habitat of endangered species and threatened species, except in accordance with provincial and federal requirements. As per Section 2.1.5 of the Provincial Policy Statement, 2020 (PPS), development and site alteration shall not be permitted in significant wildlife habitat, unless it has been demonstrated that there will be no negative impacts on the natural features or their ecological functions (PPS p. 24).

I acknowledge the findings of the Environmental Impact Study, but remain concerned about the destruction of significant natural heritage features that this development project would entail, specifically the loss of woodland area that serves as a sensitive bird breeding habitat, and the negative impact on the Eastern Meadowlark, Little Brown Myotis, Monarch butterfly, all listed as endangered or threatened. Allowing development in a SWH weakens protections for our most imperiled animals and plants. Fish habitat present through the Little Sauble River may also be impacted. Given the connectivity of natural features, the consequent negative impact of this development on the ecological functions in the surrounding area is a further source of concern.

In order to safeguard the significant natural heritage features present on the land in question and comply with the objectives set out in the Environment section of the Municipal Official Plan (specifically section C2.2.1 and C2.2.3), I also urge the Municipal Council to reverse its decision to rezone the land in question from R1 and EP to EP, OS, R3 and R4 (File Number Z-2022-084, By-law 2023-121).

Human encroachment on natural environments is creating enormous pressure on ecosystems everywhere, and while I recognize the need for affordable housing to meet the needs of our growing community, the importance of safeguarding sensitive natural

environments cannot be overstated. Nobody's quality of life will be enhanced long-term if we continue to systematically destroy the common wealth of nature that sustains us.

We can do both: meet the growing housing need through thoughtful, environmentally responsible development, while at the same time safeguarding natural environments on which we ultimately depend for all the essential services provided by functioning, healthy ecosystems. I therefore urge the Municipality and the County to work towards containing development within urban boundaries and preventing the kind of sprawl a development such as this represents. Whenever possible, urban areas should accommodate the expected population increase, leaving more rural and natural areas intact. This approach allows for efficient use of existing infrastructure, rather than having to build new infrastructure at greater cost, as well as greater damage to the environment.

It is worth noting that there are several stalled housing projects in the Municipality. Land has been cleared and continues to sit unused, while the water and sewer upgrades undertaken by the Municipality to provide necessary allotments to subdivisions that don't get built are paid for by the local taxpayers. These developments were to have provided housing for several hundred people. I urge the Planning and Development authorities to make sure these projects get completed before starting new ones that have as an added cost the destruction of fragile natural environments.

Additional items of concern relating to this proposal are: land use compatibility, infrastructure, transportation, and resource management.

In summary, the proposed development undermines regulations set out in the *Endangered Species Act*. Combating the global wildlife extinction crisis should be a priority everywhere, and every bit of saved habitat helps. I therefore urge you to do your part by denying approval to this Draft Plan of Subdivision Application, thereby strengthening the implementation of the *Endangered Species Act* to avert the extinction crisis and curtail the ongoing loss of biodiversity that is going on all around us.
