Detachment Updates

Calls For Service of Note

Violent Crimes:

Assault – There was only 1 assault investigation completed over the 2 months in Kincardine. This investigation was as a result of Intimate Partner Violence.

Other Crimes Against a Person – There were 4 incidents in total. 2 of these occurrences related to Intimate Partner Violence and the other 2 were threats made towards an individual out in the community.

Property Crimes:

Break and Enter – There was 1 Break and Enter investigated during the 2 months in Kincardine. This break and enter occurred at an unoccupied rural property where food items were stolen.

Theft Under – There were 10 theft under \$5000 investigated during this reporting period which is down significantly from the previous year. These thefts include thefts of parcels, insecure bicycles, thefts from unlocked vehicles, and shoplifting.

Fraud – There were 6 frauds reported during this period. Most of the frauds involved telephone/internet scams where approximately \$14,500 was lost by 3 victims.

Bike Patrol – Unfortunately there were no bike patrol hours dedicated in August and September as the Detachment bikes were inoperable.

Foot Patrol – Officers dedicated 65 hours of foot patrol over the 2 months in the Municipality of Kincardine.

Friday, 14 September 2023 – On this date officers conducted RIDE checks throughout the detachment area and apprehended 3 impaired drivers, issued 1 warn range suspension to a driver for having a BAC above 0, and located and charged a suspended driver.

- SRO attended a “Touch the Truck” event hosted by Elgin Market Public School for students and caregivers.
- Emergency Response Plans received and signed off for 6 schools. SRO conducted a walk through of the new addition to St Anthony’s School and provided feedback regarding lockdown best practices.
- SRO participated daily in South Bruce return to school initiative “All Boots on the Ground”. The focus of this campaign is for uniform members to conduct mobile and foot patrol to ensure the safety of students arriving/leaving school. The campaign was held for the first two weeks of the school year.
- SRO attended the Special Olympics annual qualifier as the race starter.

Staffing Updates

The month of September has been a busy one with movement of personnel. D/Cst. Brad Larson has accepted a lateral transfer into another investigative role outside of detachment. We wish Brad well in his new position and I am certain he will continue to have a positive impact on public safety. P/C Ed Brunk has accepted a lateral transfer to the Huron Detachment. Ed won’t be going far, and he will continue to excel in Huron.

On September 27th P/C Tyler Beukema accepted a lateral transfer to the South Bruce Detachment from the Wellington County Detachment. Tyler has joined ‘A’ Platoon and is a

welcomed addition to our team. Since then, PC Drew Bean has accepted a lateral transfer to the South Bruce Detachment from the Grey Bruce Detachment. Drew has joined 'A' Platoon and we are very excited to have him.

In September, A/D/Sgt. Dave Greer competed for the vacant Detective Sergeants position in South Bruce. A/D/Sgt. Greer was successful in this process and has accepted a promotion as the Area Crime Supervisor for the South Bruce Detachment. Dave has a wealth of experience with criminal investigations and we're looking forward to continuing to work with him in this role now as our permanent Detective Sergeant.
