Detachment Updates

Calls For Service of Note

Assault – 5 of the 7 assaults were domestic/familial in nature and assault charges were laid.

Break and Enter – The 2 break and enters reported were both investigated. In 1 of the incidents an individual was identified and charged. In the other incident an individual was identified and the complainant declined to lay charges.

Theft Under – Of the 7 theft under \$5000 occurrences, 2 of them were relating to thefts from unlocked vehicles, 2 of them were relating to shoplifting and 2 of them related to gas drive-off's.

Fraud – Over this reporting period 5 frauds have been investigated. Each of these frauds are unique and victims lost smaller amounts of Canadian currency.

Bike Patrol – 11.5 hours of bicycle patrols were conducted out of the South Bruce Detachment in Kincardine over this reporting period. The bicycles were out of service for a period of time.

Foot Patrol – Officers dedicated 84 hours to foot patrol in Kincardine over these 2 months.

Canada Road Safety Week – Officers dedicated significant time to Canada Road Safety Week in July and targeted the 'Big 4' causal factors in collisions causing serious injury and death. 139 charges were laid and 78 warnings were issued. This had a positive impact on traffic safety as only 15 collisions were reported during that week, and there were no serious injury collisions.

The prize was awarded to the student in a full school assembly (pizza party for his class followed). The cup sleeve will be used in local coffee shops/restaurants.
- SRO spent time at the beginning and end of the school day during the last week of school to hand out positive tickets for free Frosters to students wearing their helmets biking/scootering to school.

Community Events

Kincardine Scottish Fest – Officers attended the Kincardine Scottish Fest and conducted foot patrol throughout the weekend festival. A photo was captured and added to social media of an officer interacting with community members and trying on an armoured helmet.

Huron Bruce MADD – South Bruce OPP supported the Huron-Bruce MADD with a 'coffee cup sleeve' design art contest. PC Kevin Martin highlighted the positive work and attended a pizza party with the winning class.

OPP Veterans Day – South Bruce OPP hosted the annual OPP Veterans Day at the end of June. It was very well attended and presentations and demonstrations were given with our MCRT Program and our ALPR technology.

Kincardine Pride Parade – South Bruce OPP participated in the annual Pride Parade in Kincardine. It was extremely well-attended and officers had positive community interactions while celebrating with the community.

Staffing Updates

Inspector Krista Miller retired after 30 years of policing with the OPP and the last 5 years as the Detachment Commander in South Bruce. She had a positive impact on the detachment and in the communities that she served.

Acting Staff Sergeant Henry Thalen arrived in late June for a 3 month temporary assignment as the Operations Manager. Henry has a wealth of experience and has adjusted well to his new role.
