

Water/Wastewater Compliance Report

Drinking Water Quality Management System:

Our corrective actions to the non-conformance issues identified in the external audit conducted by NSF-ISR were approved by the auditor. A copy of the reports are included on the November 18 Consent Agenda.

Our Quality Management System Operational Plans have been revised to reflect some of the items that came out of the August Audit. Copies of these Plans (one for Municipality of Kincardine-owned drinking water systems and one for the Huronville Distribution System) will be included on the Consent Agenda.

Ministry of the Environment, Parks and Conservation:

The Inspection Reports for the Huronville Subdivision Distribution System and the Kincardine Drinking Water System were received. We received an inspection rating of 100% for each of these systems. A copy of the Huronville report was on the October 7 Consent Agenda. The Kincardine report is on the November 18 Consent Agenda.

The Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks conducted an inspection of the Scott Point Drinking Water System on October 10.

Kincardine Drinking Water System:

There was one watermain break in the Kincardine distribution system in October. The break was classified as a Category 1 break and did not require reporting to the Ministry of the Environment.
