BY-LAW

NO. 2023 -

Being a By-law to Appoint 'Principles Integrity' as the Integrity Commission for The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine

Whereas pursuant to Section 223.2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* as amended, requires that each municipality in the Province of Ontario establish codes of conduct for members of its Council and local boards; and

Whereas pursuant Section 223.3 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* as amended, requires that each municipality in the Province of Ontario appoint an Integrity Commissioner, who shall be responsible for performing in an independent manner the functions assigned by the municipality with respect to any of the matters referenced in that section; and

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine desires to appoint another Integrity Commissioner commencing January 1, 2024; now therefore be it

Resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine **Enacts** as follows:

- 1. That The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine hereby appoints Principles Integrity as Integrity Commissioner for The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine pursuant to Section 222.3 of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* as amended, for a three year term commencing on January 1, 2024.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign and execute, on behalf of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine, the Agreement with the Principles Integrity and any other associated documents to complete this contract.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect January 1st, 2024.
- 4. This by-law may be cited as the "Integrity Commissioner Appointment (Principals Integrity) By-law".
