

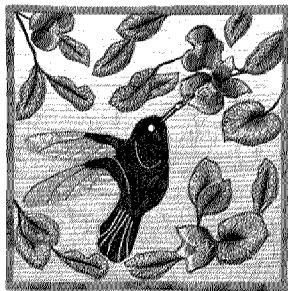
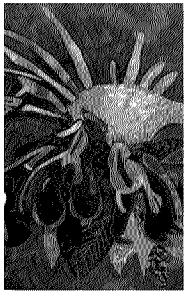

The fibre art fun continues at the Museum this month with the opening of **The Whisper Project exhibit – on now until April 30th!**

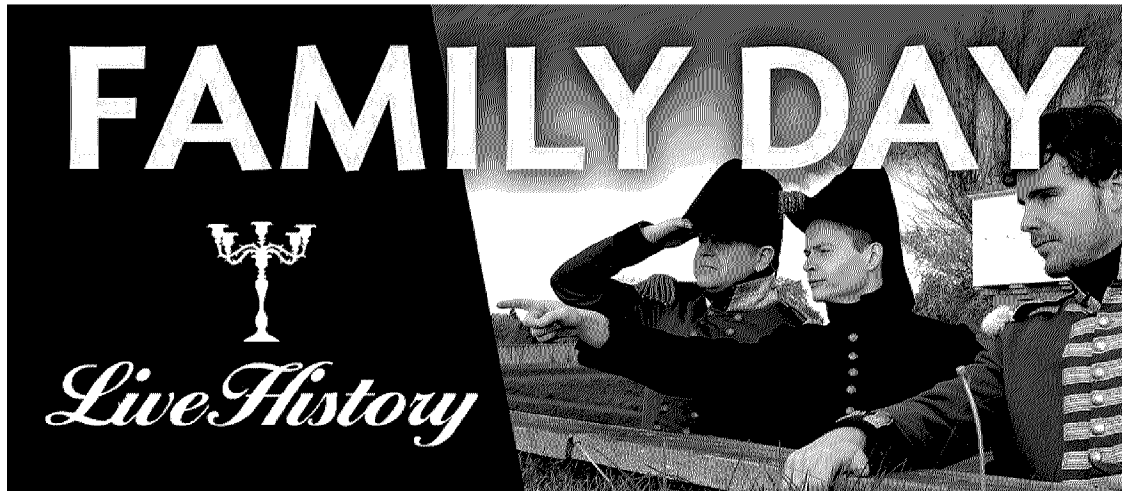

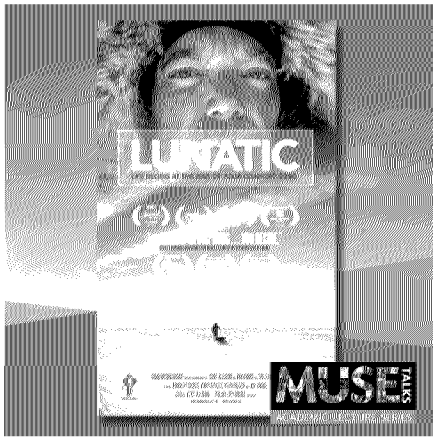
- Shows run every 15 mins and take 30-45 minutes to complete. The show is suitable for school-age children to adults.

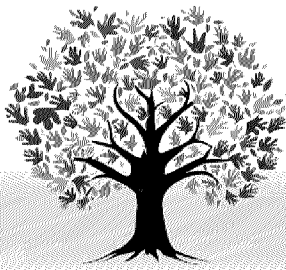
