4.1 Remembrance Day Banners

Ms. Fioze indicated that the WWI Veteran banners are in need of replacement. The Organizers are reviewing the program, and qualifications for future banners, and are reaching out to heritage groups for comments.

She added that they received over 400 responses to the online survey. Once the first phase is complete, they will present the findings to Council.

4.3 Lorie Fioze, Art Gallery

Lorie Fioze indicated that staff are looking to move all the Scugog Gallery photos into one location. They are currently on display in several locations, and some in storage.

The Committee agreed that one location would be best, if there was a location that could accommodate the collection. The photos are enjoyed during intermission when attending the theatre at the Kincardine Centre for the Arts, and would recommend a rotating digital display of all the photos in this location.
