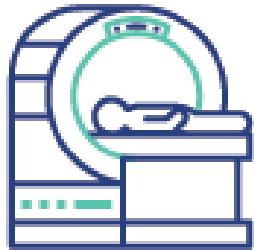

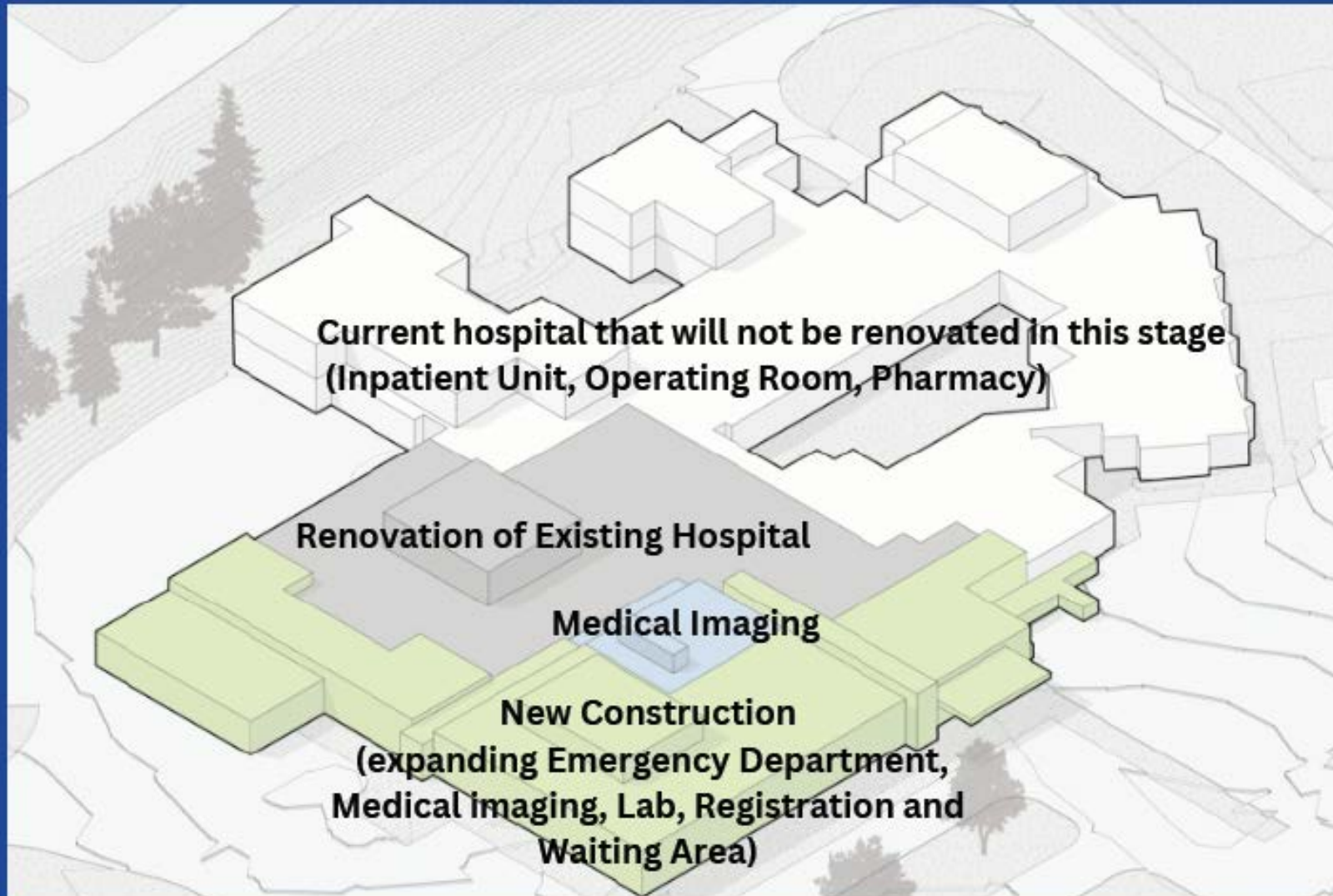

# Our Campaign Needs Everyone's Support

Our major stakeholders are stepping up:

- Municipality of Kincardine committed \$600K in 2022 & 2023.
- Township of Huron-Kinloss committed \$100K in 2022, 2023 & 2024.
- Bruce Power committed \$1.5M plus a further \$0.5M from its Bruce Power Supplier Sponsorship Program.

We have approached our major stakeholders again (plus the County of Bruce) because our new campaign goal went from \$12M to \$18M.

We need everyone's support - local businesses, community groups and individual donors. So far, we have raised over \$4M, including major donations from Duncan & Lesley Hawthorne, Hurontel, Jason & Stacey Murray, Lakeside Chevrolet, D & J Storrey Foundation & Lucknow Kinsmen.

The public phase of our campaign kicked off in June 2022 with first annual "Rock With Your Docs" (next RWYD event is June 21, 2024)
