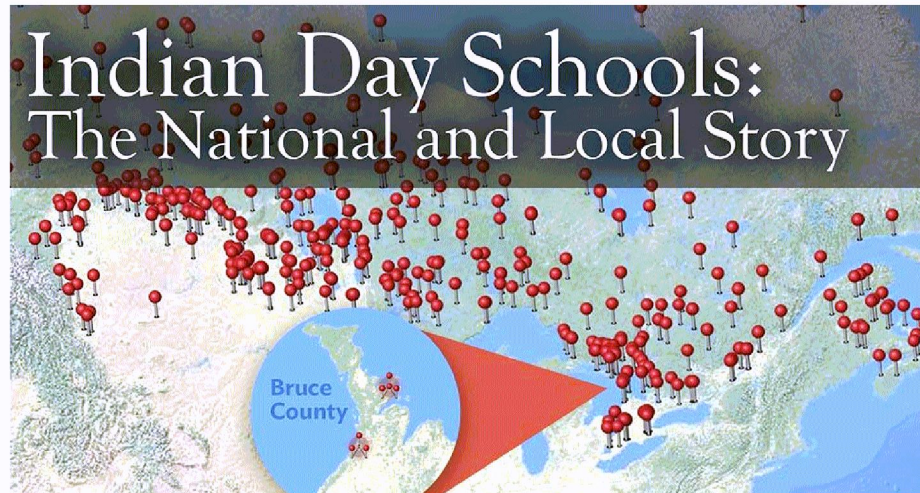

Indian Day Schools is a lesser-known subject among everyday Canadians who may be familiar with the Residential Schools System. More than 699 Indian Day Schools were established and operated by the Canadian Government since the 1920's, with 7 located in Bruce County.

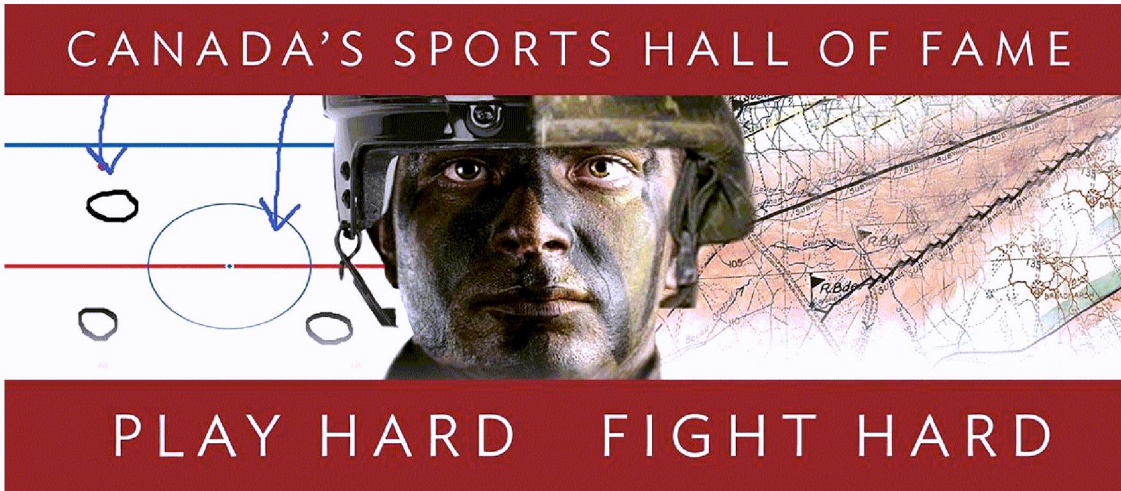
