## Executive Summary:

The Community Services Department has planned for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Council Levee to take place on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024, at the Tiverton Sports Centre and Davidson Centre. The event will promote participation in a variety of activities sponsored by the municipality including public swimming, skating and drop-in gym.

## Context and Background Information:

A levee is a celebrated tradition dating back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century that provides a positive outlook at the year ahead. Our Council Levee taking place on Tuesday, December 31, 2024, is an opportunity for our community to gather and enjoy time participating in fun, family-friendly activities.

Activities will take place at both the Tiverton Sports Centre and the Davidson Centre as follows:

- Public Skating 12-2pm, Tiverton Sports Centre
- Preschool Public Swim 10:30-11:30am & Kinder Gym 10:30-12pm, Davidson Centre
- Public Skating 2-3:30pm, Davidson Centre
- Public Swimming 1-2:30pm, Davidson Centre
- Drop in Gym 1-3:30pm, Davidson Centre

This year, with the addition of preschool activities at the Davidson Centre in the morning, we are aiming to attract families with young children to participate.

In addition to the sponsored activities, the walking track is open free for the community until 4pm on December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Over the course of the holiday break a recreation schedule of activities will be promoted for the community, including public skating at both the Davidson Centre and Tiverton Sports Centre along with public swimming and drop-in gym. Winter Break Camp days are being offered at the Davidson Centre on January 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.

A Winter Break student membership is also available as a promotion for the month of December.

The holiday break activities and the Council Levee event will be promoted through a media release, social media, newspaper, community bulletin and posters.
