
Western Waste Management Facility

- Strong safety and environmental performance continues – 8 years without a lost-time accident
- WWMF expansion continues, under 10-year license granted in 2017
- New Multi-Purpose Storage Buildings to take refurbishment and operational waste
- Upgrades to Incinerator
- Updates to Environmental Monitoring



OPG's Deep Geologic Repository

- OPG's lasting solution for low- and intermediate-level waste – proposed for the Bruce site.
- 680 metres underground in solid, impermeable rock
- Protects the lake, the environment and people
- DGR Hosting Agreement renewed in 2018, with 50% of trust monies released. Annual payments resumed at 50% level in December 2018 to 5 area municipalities.



First Nations and Métis

- OPG and Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) reached Interim Measures Agreement in 2019 on legacy issues.
- Continued community engagement sessions on the DGR. Have held close to 20 sessions in 9 locations across the province.
- SON Decision on DGR expected end of 2019.
