Western Waste Management Facility

- Strong safety performance continues: 8 years without a lost-time accident
- WWMF expansion continues:
 - 5 new Multi-Purpose Storage Buildings (3 in design phase).
 - Used Fuel Storage Buildings 5 & 6 – construction underway.
- Upgrades to incinerator – and increased incinerator throughput.



Lasting Solutions

- On Jan. 31, Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) voted to not support OPG's DGR for lower levels of waste.
- OPG respects the decision of SON.
- OPG is moving forward to develop alternate solutions for permanent disposal.
- We will engage with our stakeholders to develop an alternate site-selection process.
 - Any site-selection process will engage Indigenous peoples and municipalities
- A priority will be continuing our efforts in waste minimization
